## Certified RFID Lock with Bluetooth Low Energy (BLE)

### Requirements

- All hotel openings are required to have Mobile Guest Services and are required to activate Mobile Key.
- Existing hotels that have installed Mobile Key with certified RFID BLE locks and are included in the mKey Brand Standard, must activate immediately.
- Guestroom, common area (lobby, fitness center, elevator readers, pool, concierge lounge, etc.) and heart of house lock hardware must be replaced every 10 years.
- All lock systems are required to use certified lock vendors and certified plastic and heart of house keys.
- All key cards must be purchased from PLI, RR Donnelley or certified lock vendors.

### Annual Lock System Security + Stabilization Package

- As described in the FDD/IDD, CAPEX and OPEX budget guidelines, hotels are required to keep the lock systems up to date with the latest software, servers, and key cards to mitigate security risks (in accordance per MIP 29 and IT Sec 17/18).
